



## 2021 Scholarship Program

Marquette-Adams Telephone Cooperative, Inc. is excited to announce our 2021 Scholarship Program. Eight scholarships at \$1,500 will be available.

The scholarships will be available to high school or home schooled seniors planning to attend a college university, technical school or trade school. Scholarships will also be available to students currently attending a college university, technical school or trade school. Specific criteria must be met in order to be considered for a scholarship. The requirements of high school seniors are as follows:

The high school senior or home schooled senior and his/her parents, guardians or foster parents must be a full-time resident of the Marquette-Adams Telephone Cooperative service area and have telephone, long distance, or Internet service with Marquette-Adams Telephone Cooperative.

The requirements for current college university, technical or trade schools are as follows:

Students currently attending a college university, technical or trade school may apply for a scholarship as long as they are not a previous scholarship winner from Marquette-Adams and must meet the criteria outlined above.

Scholarships must be filled out properly, typed, printed and returned by the deadline in order to be considered.

Scholarship deadline is March 1, 2021

The successful recipients will receive the scholarship check made out to the college university, technical school or trade school of their choice from Marquette-Adams Telephone Cooperative after completing the first semester with at least a 2.0 GPA and after registering for the second semester.

***The following four items must be completed\*:***

1. List any academic distinctions or honors you have won and introduce yourself to our judges in writing (five or less lines for your introduction).
2. Note any volunteer activities in which you have been actively engaged and you feel are most meaningful to you. (Include years of participation, grade levels and any offices held)
3. List three (3) personal references, one being a High School English Teacher if you are a High School applicant. **Please include at least one (1) written recommendation.**
4. Please include a photo (senior picture if possible) with application. *The scholarship winners' photos will be displayed in our quarterly newsletter once they are chosen. (Include physical photo with application, or mail digital photo separately to pscully@maadtelco.com)*

*\* Scholarships must be filled out properly, typed, printed and returned with **ALL** required materials referenced above by 4:30 PM on March 1, 2021 in order to be considered.*

*Applications that fail to meet **ALL** of these requirements will not be viewed by the committee.*
