SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Marquette-Adams Telephone Cooperative, Inc. will award up to eight (8) \$1,500 academic scholarships in 2024. Eligible applicants include high school or home schooled seniors planning to attend a college university, technical school or trade school in the fall of 2024. Students currently attending a college university, technical school, or trade school are also eligible to apply.

## **ELIGIBILITY**:

Applicant and his/her parents, guardians, or foster parents must be full-time residents of the Marquette-Adams Telephone Cooperative serving area and subscribe to telephone, long distance, or Internet service with Marquette-Adams Telephone Cooperative.

Previous Marquette-Adams scholarship winners are not eligible to win a second time.

Applications must be completed, typed, printed, and submitted prior to the deadline in order to be considered.

## ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN MARCH 1, 2024.

Successful applicants is will receive a check in the amount of \$1,500 made out to the college university, technical school, or trade school of their choice from Marquette-Adams upon successful completion of their first semester in which they achieve at least a 2.0 GPA and have registered for a second semester.

The following five items must **ALL** be completed in order to be eligible:

- **1. Introduce yourself** to our scholarship committee in writing (five or less lines) and note any academic distinctions or honors you have received.
- 2. Note any volunteer activities in which you have been actively engaged and feel are most meaningful to you (include years of participation, grade levels and any offices held).
- **3. List three (3) personal references.** Please include at least one (1) written recommendation.
- **4. Produce scholarship application essay:** In 500 words or less, describe your most meaninful achievements and how they relate to your field of study and your future goals.
- **5.** Please include a photo (senior picture preferred if possible) with application. You may include a physical photo along with your application, or you may mail a digital photo separately to info@marquetteadams.com. The winners' photos will appear in our quarterly newsletter once they are selected.

Applications must be completed, printed, and submitted along with ALL required materials referenced above by 4:30 PM on March 1, 2024 in order to be considered. Applications that fail to include all required materials will not be viewed or considered by the committee.
